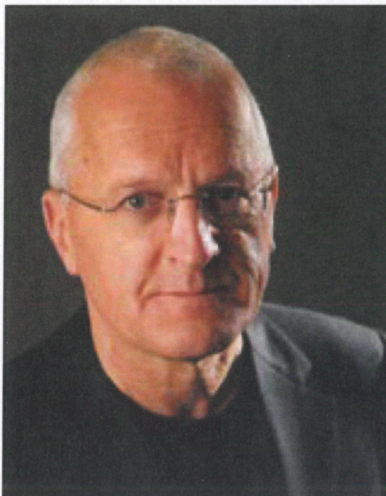


## Brief Bio – Pat Knoll
